- 1. The Strathbogie State Forest is State Forest reserved under s 42(1) of the *Forests Act* 1958 (Vic).
- 2. The applicant is an association incorporated under the *Associations Incorporation Reform Act* 2012 (Vic).
- 3. The applicant has at all relevant times:
 - had objects or purposes that included the protection or conservation of, or research into, the environment including protecting the Strathbogie State Forest from inappropriate management; and
 - engaged in a series of activities related to the protection or conservation of, or research into, the environment, including protecting the Strathbogie State Forest from inappropriate management.
- 4. The respondent is the responsible agency of the State of Victoria with the function of managing the Strathbogie State Forest under the *Forests Act 1958* (Vic).
- 5. In November 2019, the Strathbogie State Forest was designated as an Immediate Protection Area by the Victorian Government under the Victorian Forestry Plan.

- 6. The respondent proposes to cause fire to burn through areas of the Strathbogie State Forest as depicted in maps set out in Attachment A to this Statement of Claim at dates yet to be determined in the period between March-May 2024 (planned burning).
- 7. The species known as *Petauroides volans*, or the Southern Greater Glider, resides within the Strathbogie State Forest.

Particulars

About 93 Southern Greater Gliders were detected by surveys in the Strathbogie State Forest in about January and February 2023 in the areas the subject of the planned burning. A copy of the survey report will be produced on request.

The Southern Greater Glider is recorded as likely to occur in the Strathbogie State Forest in the species profile of the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water. A copy of the species profile will be produced on request.

The Southern Greater Glider is recorded as likely to occur in the Strathbogie State Forest in the conservation advice for the Southern Greater Glider produced by the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water. A copy of the conservation advice will be produced on request.

Further particulars may be provided following discovery, or before trial.

8. The Southern Greater Glider is a species listed under the "endangered" category under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (Cth) (**the EPBC Act**).

Particulars

The Southern Greater Glider was listed as endangered on 5 July 2022. The listing assessment is included in the conservation advice for the Southern Greater Glider produced by the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water. A copy of the conservation advice will be produced on request.

- 9. Under s 18(3) of the EPBC Act, a person must not take an action that:
 - a. has or will have a significant impact on a listed threatened species included in the endangered category; or

- b. is likely to have a significant impact on a listed threatened species included in the endangered category.
- 10. The planned burning in the Strathbogie State Forest constitutes an action that:
 - a. will have a significant impact on; or
 - b. is likely to have a significant impact on;

the Southern Greater Glider, in that fire:

- c. leads to a long-term decrease in the size of an important population of Southern Greater Glider;
- d. reduces the area of occupancy of an important population of Southern Greater Glider;
- e. adversely affects habitat critical to the survival of the Southern Greater Glider.

Particulars

The decline of the Southern Greater Glider is accelerated by fire including because:

- (a) Some Southern Greater Gliders are killed directly by fire, being between 1-9 per cent of animals in the path of fire.
- (b) The Southern Greater Glider is dependent on hollow-bearing trees and low-severity planned burns cause hollow-bearing trees to decline by up to 26 percent.
- (c) Fire causes loss of food resources.

Further particulars may be provided following discovery, or before trial.

- 11. By reason of the matters set out in paragraph 10, the planned burning in the Strathbogie State Forest will be a contravention of s 18(3) of the EPBC Act.
- 12. The applicant claims the following relief:

- a. an injunction pursuant to s 475(2) of the EPBC Act restraining the respondent from undertaking or authorising the planned burning in the Strathbogie State Forest;
- b. costs;
- c. such further or other relief as the Court considers appropriate.
- 13. The applicant also claims the following interlocutory relief:
 - an interim injunction pursuant to s 475(5) of the EPBC Act restraining the respondent from undertaking or authorising the planned burning in the Strathbogie State Forest until further order.
